# **Harvard's Project Implicit**

This study examines people's **implicit** (unconscious) biases in a variety of areas, including **gender and science**. They have found that implicit biases are pervasive, that people are often unaware of their implicit biases, that our implicit biases predict behavior and that people differ in their level of implicit bias. They have developed a number of online **surveys to test implicit bias**.
